Harvest Success

After preparation of the soil with green manures (peas, field beans), especially cauliflower and broccoli could flourish well this year.

About the overabundant moisture in Spring, we had already told you. As expected according to this, the strawberry harvest was short this year.

Due to the dry and hot Summer, the Kirschessigfliege (Drosophila suzukii) didn't damage our berries as much as last year. Therefore, we could be content with the raspberry harvest.
